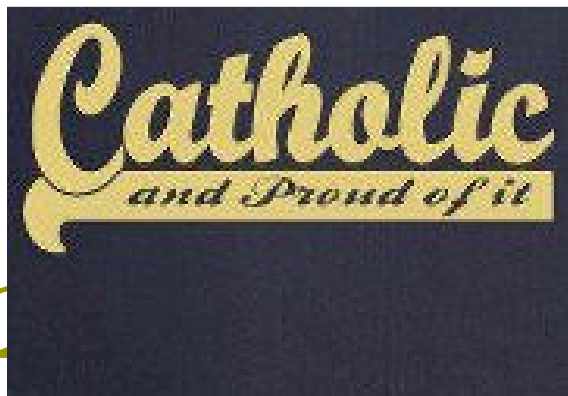

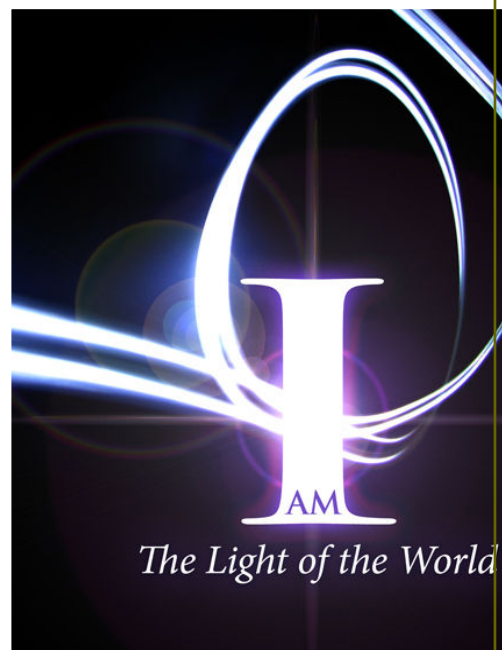

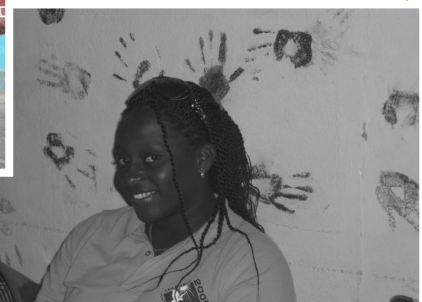
So for everyone who missed it you truly a night with a difference.
