The gathering of Catechist and Youth Leaders from the Diocese of St. John's Bassetere converged in The Valley, Anguilla from September 27-30, 2012 with the theme "Celebrating the Year of Faith". The experiences of the participants were described as rich and deeply rewarding. Some of the sub-themes being explored at this years conference include; Stages of Faith Development, Technology Tools for Faith Development, Overview on the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Overview of the Second Vatican Council, Understanding the Sacrament of Matrimony, Development in the Catechetical and Youth Ministries, and Diocesan Vision for Catechesis and Youth Ministries.

Participants were asked to reflect specifically on their respective program areas, as they explored ways to better understand those entrusted to their care and choose appropriate teaching methods and practices.

At the end of the two-days session, some participants did an island tour while others enjoyed a day trip over to St. Maarten via ferry. On Sunday, Mass was led by the youth and the homily encouraged all to continue the journey in faith..
